

Use of DARPA Photography and Audiovisual Materials

GENERAL CONDITIONS:

DARPA photographs and audiovisual materials may not be used to state or imply the endorsement by DARPA, the Department of Defense or by any DARPA employee of a commercial product, service or activity, or used in any other manner that might mislead.

DARPA should be acknowledged as the source of its material.

It is unlawful to falsely claim copyright or other rights in DARPA material.

DARPA shall in no way be liable for any costs, expenses, claims or demands arising out of use of DARPA's audiovisual materials and photographs by a recipient's distributees.

DARPA personnel are not authorized to sign indemnity or hold harmless statements, release from copyright infringement, or documents granting exclusive use rights.

PHOTOGRAPHY:

Photographs are not protected by copyright unless noted. If copyrighted, permission should be obtained from the copyright owner prior to use. If not copyrighted, photographs may be reproduced and distributed without further permission from DARPA. DARPA does not sign release forms for such materials. If a recognizable person appears in a photograph, use for commercial purposes may infringe a right of privacy or publicity and permission should be obtained from the recognizable person.

AUDIO RECORDING:

Audiotape recordings are not protected by copyright unless noted. A cassette may be excerpted or reproduced and distributed without further permission from DARPA. DARPA does not sign release forms for such materials. However, use of a portion or segment of an audiotape, such as talent, narration or music, may infringe a right of publicity or copyright and permission should be obtained from the source.

VIDEO AND MOTION PICTURE RECORDINGS:

Videotape and Motion Picture recordings are not protected by copyright unless noted. A DARPA recording may be reproduced and distributed without further permission from DARPA, unless otherwise directed by DARPA. DARPA does not sign release forms for such materials. Copyrighted music or footage, which is incorporated in a production, may not be used unless permission is obtained from the copyright owner. While in most instances using non-copyrighted segments is permitted, use for commercial purposes of a portion or segment containing talent or recognizable person may infringe a right of privacy or publicity and permission should be obtained from the recognizable person. These guidelines also apply to any DARPA-sponsored satellite feed of audiovisual materials.
